The Florida Environmental Public Health Tracking (EPHT) Program is a Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) grant-funded project subject to ongoing development. Florida is one of 16 states and one city that are partnering with the CDC in the development of the National Environmental EPHT Network. Similar key health and environmental data measures (also called indicators) have been chosen to match those of other EPHT grantees so that information provided by the indicators can be compared between and across geographical areas.

The Florida EPHT web portal is a warehouse for collected data on chronic diseases and environmental hazards. Although each type of data set may appear on the same map, no relationship between environmental hazard and health outcome is expressed or implied in the absence of a controlled epidemiological study.

The data, indicators, associated metadata, and contextual material found here will change over time. Because of reporting delays and indicator derivation schema, state data and federal data may be inconsistent with data derived from other sources. Many of the indicators developed for the Florida EPHT web portal are based on interpretations that have significance at the state scale. Data acquired from state databases that contain identifiable personal information have been aggregated or suppressed to preserve confidentiality.
