

History of Florida Environmental Public Health Tracking (FL EPHT)

2002- Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) established the National Tracking Network

2003- FL EPHT established with CDC funding

2009- Launched web portal FloridaTracking.com

2012- Released data reports by county

2014- Released data reports by ZIP Code

- Health advocates can document environmental health issues in their community
- Public health professionals can use the data to better design programs and interventions
- Decision makers can inform stakeholders and support public policy
- Students and researchers can use data in projects, studies and research
- Healthcare professionals can advise patients based on environmental and health data specific to their community
